Queensland–China Climate Change Fellowship Program

Grants available

Climate change is one of the most important issues of our generation. It needs serious and immediate action. You can be part of the solution.

The Queensland Government and the Ministry of Science and Technology in China are pleased to announce the Queensland–China Climate Change Fellowship Program for 2008.

The Fellowships are designed to bring together Queensland and Chinese researchers and other professionals to strengthen collaborative links that improve understanding and knowledge of climate change, its impacts, and mitigation and adaptation approaches.

Funding grants are valued between A\$5000 and \$8000 to support a two to four week exchange at a relevant host organisation in China and to build professional relationships and capture opportunities in priority areas.



Fellowships are open to:

- doctorate students and post-doctoral researchers
- early to mid-career researchers
- business and industry professionals
- government decision-makers including policy officers and advisors (state and local).

Priority areas

The priority areas of climate change research and planning are water, human settlements, natural environment and landscape, housing, emergency services, human health, tourism, business and industry, agriculture, and state and local government policy and planning.
